

PROCLAMTION

WHEREAS, many thousands of veterans of the United States of America's armed forces have served this nation in times of peace and war, and in doing so have thereby assured the safety and prosperity of all her people, and as we celebrate our freedom, we should remember this was a gift of life given to each of us by the men and women who bravely served their country, and by those who gave their life in battle; and

WHEREAS, the United States Merchant Marine has played a critical role in every major American military conflict since the American Revolution (1775-1783), transporting large amounts of war material, supplies, equipment and troops, and during World War II, they were vital to the war effort, contributing to the Allied victory; and

WHEREAS, the United States Merchant Marine suffered great casualties during World War II with more than 8,650 of the 215,000 Mariners killed and 3.1 tons of merchant ships lost, and the sacrifices that were made ensured our liberty and the American way of life; and

WHEREAS, founded in 1984, the American Merchant Marine Veterans (AMMV) is a non-profit Veterans national organization that includes a Florida charter, and its mission is in educating people about the vital role in which the United States Merchant Marine has played in the history of our nation, and seeks recognition for the sacrifices and contributions made by the men and women who have served, and continue to serve in times of peace and war; and

WHEREAS, the AMMV is hosting its 33rd Annual Merchant Marine Veterans' National Convention and Reunion on March 21-24, 2019 at The Westshore Grand Hotel in Tampa, Florida, and the event features speakers, a dinner cruise, a special tour of the SS American Victory Ship, and keynote speaker Rita Cosby, Emmy Award Winner, Author, Television Host, News Reporter, and Veterans Advocate.







Dedicated to the memory of the 5,652 brave merchant seaman who unselfishly gave their lives aboard 735 merchant ships that were sunk by the enemy during World War II. Also to the 1,810 U.S. Navy Armed Guard who lost their lives in defending the merchant ships against the enemy during WWII.

Without regard for personal safety, these brave merchant seamen were all volunteers; preformed the duties required in the transporting of the Armed Forces and supplies to all theaters of action making a monumental contribution to the ultimate allied victory of World War II.

Never quitting until that final telegraph had been answered:

"Finish with engines"

We dedicated this memorial May 31st, 1995 American Merchant Marine Veterans Midwest Chapter The Midwest Chapter placed this plaque at the Navy Pier in Chicago in May 1995. It has a relief depicting a sailor and two ships, one of which is sinking.


